UPDATED NOTICE RE: Sale of 13 Speedwell Way (Scott's house) Special Church Meeting - TODAY

We will be holding a Special Church Members Meeting immediately after the service to update members on the current situation concerning the house jointly owned by Scott and Life, and to formally approve a few necessary resolutions so that an offer can be accepted and a sale can proceed smoothly.

Please could visitor and those that are not yet members go through for coffee directly after the service, the rest of the church should follow 10-15 mins afterwards!

The agenda for the meeting will be as follows:

- 1) Update on the current situation in respect of the house sale - The house is under offer and a Mr & Mrs Popa are now in the proceeds of buying the house.
- 2) Appointment of team to support Julie and Hilary - John Millborrow and Anna Pisani to manage the sale on behalf of Life.
- 3) Authorising the team to accept an offer of not less than £240,000 for the house and to proceed to completion of the sale on behalf of the church.
- 4) Consider options should a sale not be proceeding within the timeframe*

*We are also provisionally planning a Members Meeting on the evening of Mon. 21 July, to consider options should the sale "fall through" see briefing note (at the moment this additional meeting seems unnecessary).

THE CENTRE NEEDS YOUR CUSTOM!

The Centre is the most visible witness of the unity of the church in Horsham. If the Christians in the town do not support it by buying their books etc there it will perhaps not be able to continue for more than a year or two and that would be a great shame. PLEASE lets remember the Centre and its important ongoing witness when we are tempted to buy from Amazon or elsewhere on the internet. If they don't have what we want they can order it for us.

Resource partner churches - Churches are asked to run a small sale or return table once a month or so on Sundays.

Life Church has been a partner for the last 10 years and have received a 10% discount on all we buy as a church there. From this month however this privilege is only for those churches who run a sale or return book table even occasionally at their services. It would be helpful for us too to have a book table at church but it needs coordinating. Would anyone be prepared to serve God in this way - helping out the Centre and making recommended books easily available to us? Is this a project for someone from the existing Life Book Club perhaps?? Speak to Julie if you feel you could do this for an initial period of a year perhaps.

THE CENTRE NEEDS VOLUNTEERS!

Doug Fletcher has sent me a letter containing an urgent request for more volunteers to work at The Centre for a few hours on a weekly, fortnightly or even monthly basis, either in a role within the Café or the Bookshop. I know that many of you currently do work there, or have done so in the past, but for those of you who would like to try something new, I have a supply of volunteer forms, which also provide more information about the work undertaken.

Apparently 2008 is the year The Centre hoped to expand into No. 3 South Street. However this plan has had to be delayed for a further 2 years due to a number of "challenges" - sales in the bookshop have fallen due to the Internet, increased prices have reduced profitability in the Café and a reduction in the number of volunteers has meant more staff have to be paid.
